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## **ABSTRACT**

A culture of tolerance, non-violence, non-conflict communication, listening and reasoning, arguing with the opponent,

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not turning him into an enemy should be cultivated from childhood." Therefore, educational work with young people should not be limited to the transfer of certain knowledge. First and foremost, youth groups need to develop and promote skills that can withstand conflicts between different nationalities and ethnic groups. It is also necessary to support those who have experienced various difficulties among young people, to intensify efforts to show compassion to those in need.

"In 1995, UNESCO issued the Declaration of Principles of Tolerance. Tolerance is an international term that means not only tolerance, but also the unity of humanity, equality of respect and relations, the richness and diversity of cultures, the recognition of rights and freedoms, the rejection of war and the establishment of a culture of peace. The United Nations has announced the signing of the Declaration on International Day for Tolerance, emphasizing the importance of adopting the principles of tolerance in the life of the international community. " So, in our multi-ethnic country, the issue of promoting and ensuring tolerance is very important. The main tasks of ensuring interethnic relations among young people, the development of a culture of communication in modern conditions can be attributed to the specific signs of mutual understanding and solidarity among young people.

In today's world, the concept of multiculturalism and cultural diversity is expanding. It is important to adapt young people to different values in the presence of different cultures, to direct the interaction between young people with different traditions to ensure interethnic harmony.

The Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan on the approval of the "Concept of State Policy of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the field of interethnic relations" emphasizes the ongoing globalization and transformation in international and regional relations, growing economic, political, national, religious and other conflicts. And in the context of growing confrontation in cyberspace, a number of pressing issues in the field of further development of interethnic relations and friendly relations with foreign countries remain, and special attention will be paid to the following issues:

"Further increase the level of cooperation between government agencies and organizations, local executive authorities and civil society institutions in the field of further development of interethnic relations and friendly relations with foreign countries;

Establish a system and mechanisms for monitoring the state of interethnic relations on the ground as a basis for the organization of activities for the early prevention of potential conflicts in society;

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Implementation of a set of educational, informational and cultural-educational measures to foster a culture of interethnic relations, study the history and traditions of the people of Uzbekistan;

To improve the training, retraining and advanced training of specialists of government agencies, as well as employees of other organizations in the field of further development of interethnic relations and friendly relations with foreign countries."

The concept of interethnic harmony and religious tolerance envisaged in the decree is one of the main directions of the idea of national independence, which has been going on for many years between the representatives of different nationalities and ethnic groups living in our country, the Uzbek people. It embodies human qualities such as friendship, kinship, kindness, brotherhood, unity, kinship, solidarity. The existence of human relations, such as mutual respect, friendship and solidarity between the citizens of Uzbekistan, living in one place and working towards the same goal, and the development of such relations - interethnic relations forms the basis of the idea of harmony.

Uzbekistan is a country of more than 130 nationalities and ethnic groups. Each nation formed in the territory of the republic has its own culture, customs and characteristics. development of international cooperation and friendly relations with foreign countries, support of compatriots and close cooperation with the Uzbek diaspora abroad in order to strengthen interethnic relations, protect the rights, freedoms and legitimate interests of citizens in the country and abroad, increase the prestige and image of Uzbekistan in the world arena;

There is no doubt that the improvement of the organizational and legal framework of interethnic relations, taking into account the priorities of the Republic of Uzbekistan in the development of the state and society, advanced foreign experience, will bring interethnic relations to a new level.

We believe that in the minds of young people there are the following needs in the field of education for the positive development of interethnic relations:

First of all, it is necessary to improve the educational process in the education system in order to harmonize interethnic relations in the minds of young people. In particular, it is important to introduce special subjects in the teaching of social sciences and humanities that promote interethnic harmony;
